Chief Vincent Dunn, FDNY (ret), will share his forty years of firefighting experiences in a seminar **FIREFIGHTING STRATEGY AND TACTICS**. Chief Dunn will discuss in detail: hose line placement, searching for victims, primary venting techniques, aerial and ground ladder placement, how fire spreads and collapse dangers when firefighting at private dwellings; strip stores; and 3 story row houses. Dunn will also examine firefighter death and injury, fire spread and structural failure in the five common construction types and identify warning signs of flashover and backdraft explosions.
